## Steps urged to overcome gas crisis

KARACHI, Dec 31: Gas crisis is not only crippling industry, but also resulting in unemployment across the country which may lead to chaos and anarchy in all major cities and towns.

This was stated by chairman, Pakistan Apparel Forum (PAF) M Jawed Bilwani, in a statement issued on Saturday.

He said the government should wake up before it sweeps away everything because presently industrial activity is at its lowest ebb.

The gas crisis was not only damaging industrial activity but also damaging exports which are vital for country's balance of trade and earning of foreign exchange, he added.

Mr Bilwani said the valueadded textile sector was already over- burdened with other costs and higher gas tariffs and shortage has made it difficult for the industry to meet its export contracts.

The employment generated by the industry, he said is even much more than the government but it seems that there was no realisation to this fact.

Nowhere in the world, industries are discouraged and crushed, but in our country the government is out to ruin industry at the cost of supply of gas to CNG sector.

He said globally and even in the neighbouring countries top priority is given to industrial sector, keeping in view enormous employment generated and huge amount of foreign exchange earned by the export sector.

All sorts of facilities and infrastructure are provided to the industry on priority but in our country, the industry is not only being neglected but all decisions are being taken at its cost.

He further said that the masses first need jobs and then anything else because without having income they even could not use CNG or gas.
