As you are aware that the Government of Pakistan announced the Strategic Trade Policy Framework 2012-15 on 30-01-2013 with a view to achieve target of US\$ 95 Billion export during the period by focusing on the following measures:-

- a. Institutional strengthening and governance.
- b. Measures to enhance Export competitiveness.
- c. Regulatory amendments in the trade regulations

2. While regulatory amendments have been made part of the Export Policy and Import Policy Orders issued vide SROs 192(I)/2013 & 193(I)/2013, dated 08-03-2013, work on some of the export development initiatives has also been initiated.


3. To further facilitate the trade, the Ministry of Commerce is formulating Strategic Trade Policy Supplement 2013-14 within the parameters of STPF 2012-15. All concerned are requested to forward their proposals with regards to STPF 2012-15 by **30th May 2013**, to enable this Ministry to start consultation/discussion with the concerned stakeholders before taking it further to the Cabinet for formal approval.

Since proposals are to be examined in detail and have to pass through a number of stages, therefore it may please be noted that if the proposals are not received by specified date, this Ministry would not be in a position to consider the same, irrespective of their merits. Focal points for further discussion may also be indicated.
