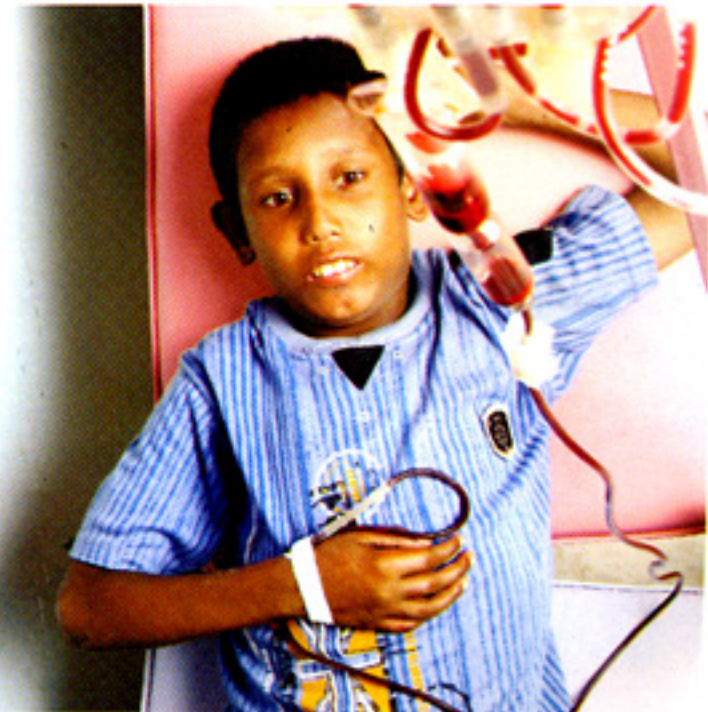
Our History

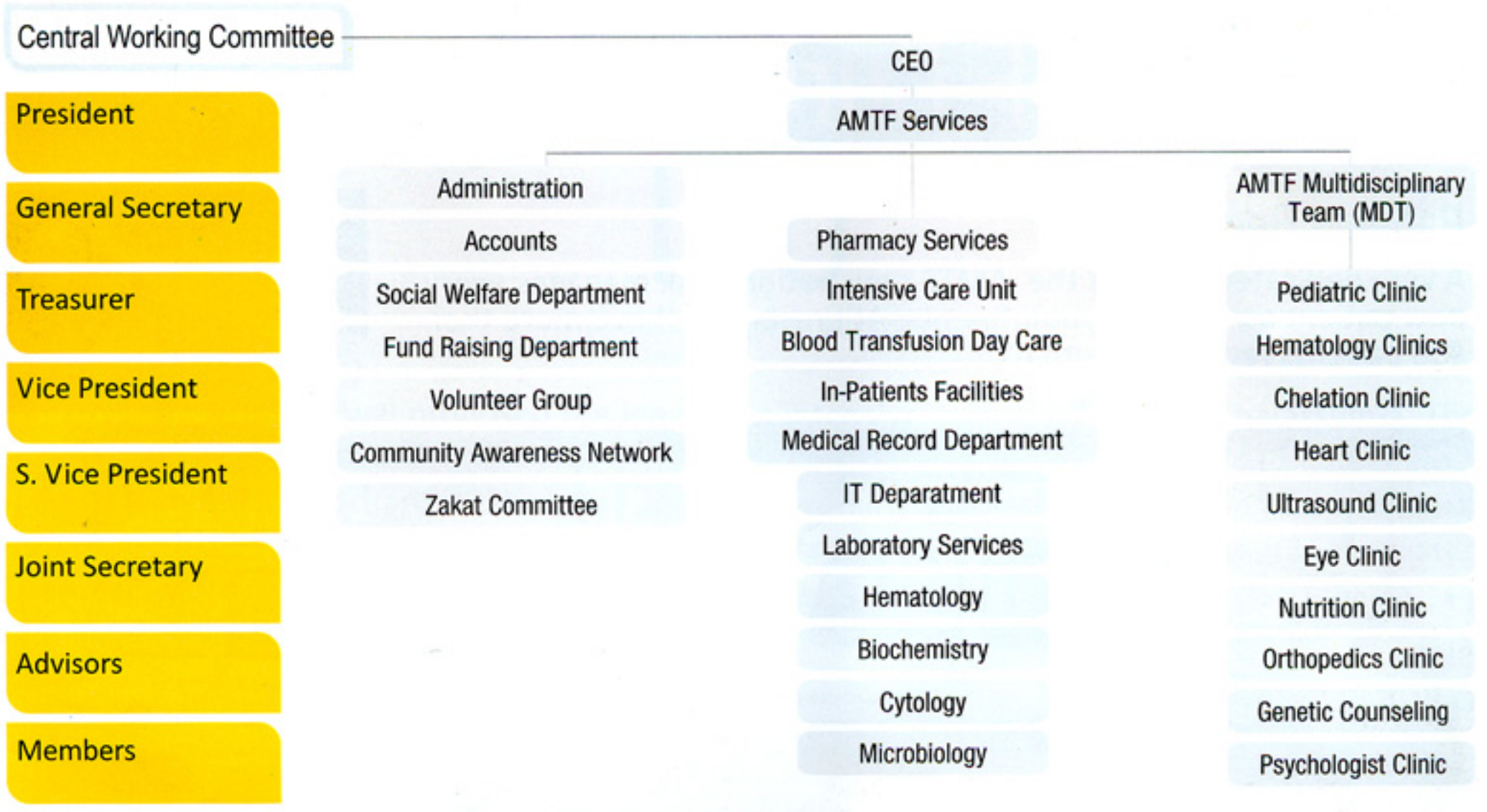
In November 2003, Dr. Asim Qidwai in collaboration with Thalassemia parents decided to establish a foundation for Inherited Blood Disorder with a special interest in Haemoglobinopathies.

The project started as a two room clinic and a day care unit in 2003 in Karachi. The hopes were high and feelings were strong. The journey which started with few steps soon developed into a two floor clinic providing services free of cost to Thalassemia patients in Karachi.

The Foundation has achieved phenomenal growth, thanks to the support from hundreds of individuals and corporate donors.

Today, AMTF proudly stands as Pakistan's first Thalassemia centre with ICU facilities and a multidisciplinary team under one roof, providing services free of cost irrespective of cast and creed.

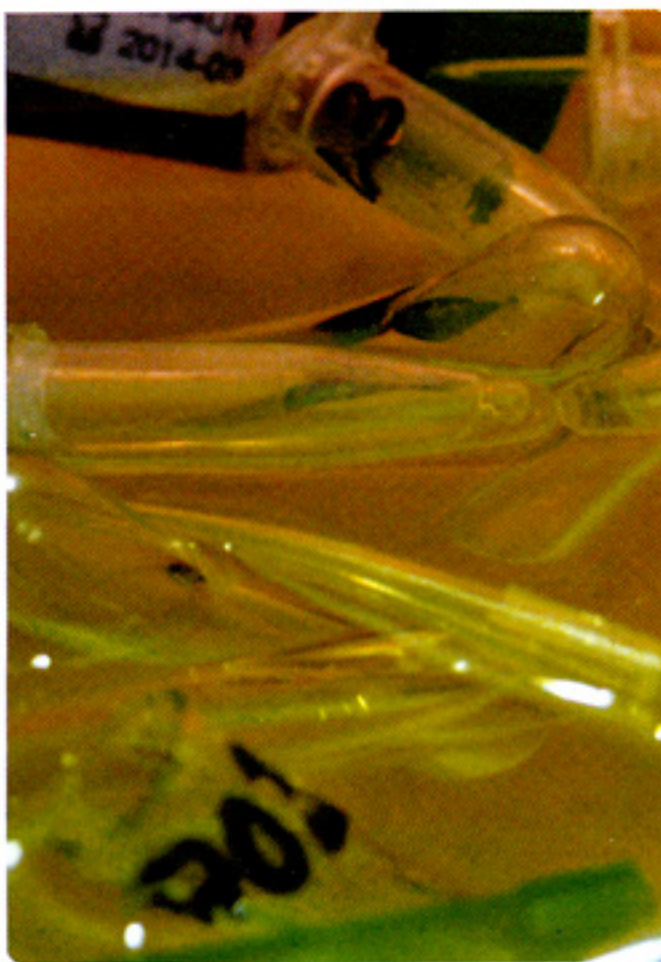
Patients Registration

A very dedicated team at the AMTF registration desk manages every new patient as well as appointments. At present we have more than 438 patients registered with us.



Efforts to improve compliance

Majority of our patients are non-affording, they cannot afford the transport expenses. We provide assistance to reach hospital in time and ultimately it improves the compliance towards the treatment.

Pakistan's First **Thalassemia** ICU

(Established in 2012)

In 2011, Dr. Asim Qidwai proposed the idea of an intensive care unit (ICU) for Thalassemia. The Government of Japan supported the cause and approved the project in August 2011. The project was completed in February, 2012 and at present is working successfully. Intensive care unit (ICU) is a 5 bedded unit with ventilator support and centralized HEPA filter system. The ICU comprises of a dedicated team working 24 hours for treating sick patients. Credit for this also goes to Mr. Ateeq ur Rehman (Advisor AMTF) for his efforts in establishing Pakistan's First Thalassemia ICU at AMTF .



Pakistan's First Thalassemia Heart Clinic

AMTF has started Pakistan's First Heart Clinic for Thalassemia Patients. The heart clinic is running successfully under supervision of pediatric cardiologist team. The project is funded by Government of Japan.



AMTF Haematology Clinics

At present AMTF is running free of cost Multisystem evaluation specialities successfully. These services include Chelation, Psychology, Nutritional, Cardiology, Orthopedics, Adolescence and Endocrine clinics for Haemoglobinopathies and other Blood disorders.



Pakistan's First Thalassemia Eye Clinic

Inaugurated in early 2012. This unit is an integral part of the facilities at AMTF.

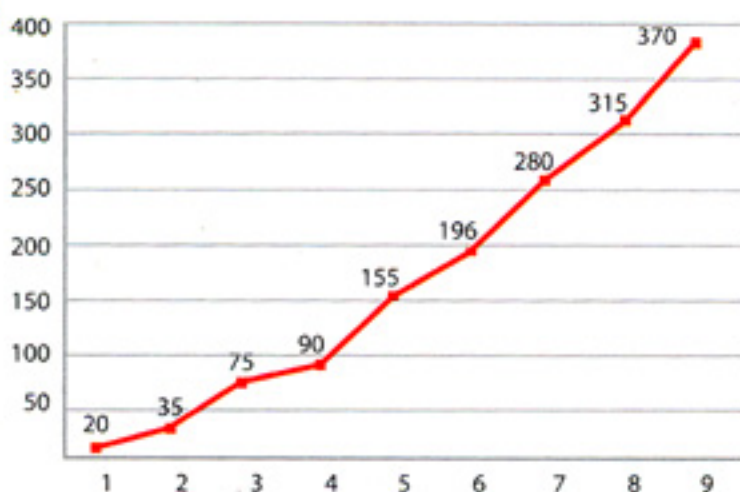

Number of Registered Patients Per Year (2003-2011)

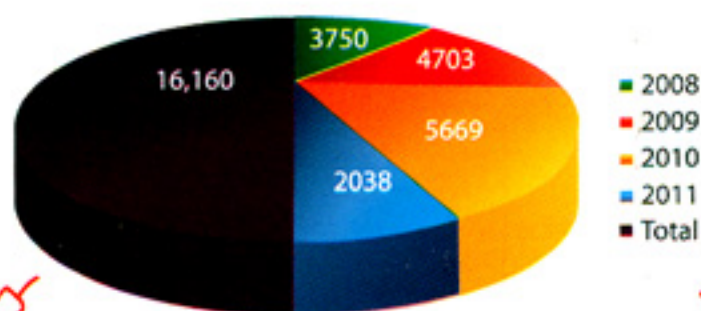


Future Plans

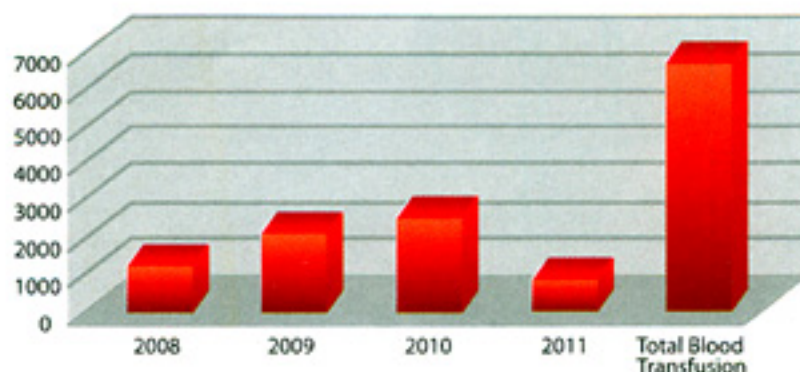
- To build a Center for Child Blood Disorder and availability of all the medical treatment and to conduct research in this field for a better future.
