SUBJECT: ETABLISHMENT OF COMPLAINT CELL

In compliance of Board's direction conveyed vide letter No. 1(41)/E&C/2020 dated 27.08.2020 a **Complaint Cell** is established in MCC (Exports), Karachi. It will be headed by the Collector, MCC (Exports), Karachi and will consist of the following members:

- 2. The Complaint Cell, hereinafter mentioned as Cell, shall look into the complaints, to judge their merit and to take corrective measures. Following procedure shall be adopted for receipt, acknowledgement and prompt redressal of grievances/complaints of the taxpayers and general public:
 - a. Anyone with a genuine grievance or any taxpayer/person aggrieved of maladministration of personnel of MCC (Exports), Karachi may lodge a complaint
 - b. In case the complainant is unwilling to appear in person, grievances/complaints may be sent in writing by post to the Cell or by mail at mccexportskarachi@gmail.com.
 - c. Written complaints must bear the signature of the complainant and complete mailing address with telephone or cell phone number.
 - d. The Cell shall acknowledge the receipt of the complaint either through email, letter or phone, allot a complaint number and communicate to the complainant for future reference.
 - e. The Cell shall be bound to respond in writing within two weeks of receipt of complaint.
 - f. The Cell shall formally review all complaints and will prepare statistical reports about the number of complaints received, complaints redressed and number of pending complaints which require further action or guidance from the higher authorities.
 - g. All complaints referred to the Cell shall be entered in specified registers to be maintained for this purpose by the Assistant / Deputy Collector (HQs). The number of complaints received settled or pending will be reported to the Board every month.
