ORDER

S.R.O. 177(I)/2022. – In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950 (XXXIX of 1950), the Federal Government is pleased to direct that the following further amendment shall be made in the Export Policy Order, 2020, namely:-

In the aforesaid Order, in paragraph 4, in sub-paragraph-(4), in clause (d), for sub-clause (ii), the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"(ii) any number of samples subject to the condition that their free on board (FOB) value does not exceed twenty-five thousand US dollars or 0.1% of actual export proceeds during the last fiscal year in US dollars, whichever is higher, per exporter per annum except automobile manufacturers who may export samples for FOB value not exceeding one hundred thousand US dollars and pharmaceutical exporting companies which may export free samples to the extent of ten percent of the commercial exports quantity of preceding year. However, pharmaceutical exporting companies may export free samples to the extent of twenty per cent of the quantity of first consignment at the time of launch of a product."
