SUBJECT: <u>STAKEHOLDERS INPUT/CONSULTATION ON UPCOMING TEXTILE POLICY</u> 2019-24.

Textile sector occupies a pivotal position in Pakistan's economy. It has the most intensive backward and forward linkages compared to any other sector. Linking agriculture through industry to exports is a distinction that is unique to textile sector. It contributes nearly 8% of country's GDP, 21% in large scale manufacturing, employees 40% of industrial work force, consumes 36% of bank credit to manufacturing and accounts of nearly 60% for our exports.

- 2. Unlike some other textiles and clothing producing countries, Pakistan is unique in a way that it has a self-reliant production chain. From cotton to ginning, polyester, weaving, processing, finishing and from fabrics to home textiles and apparel, all are linked in the textiles and clothing value chain which are and have been developed by its own industry.
- 3. To achieve competitiveness and value addition, the government approved first-ever Textile Policy of the country in 2009 for the period of five years; 2009-14. The second textiles policy for next five years was approved in 2015 for period 2014-19. Textile policies not only laid down a perspective plan for five years (each), but also brought coherence among the various support measures and development initiatives of the government aimed at promotion and uplifting of the biggest industrial sector of country in post-quota scenario.
- 4. Textile policy addresses areas related to the export development, market access, institutional strengthening, and regulatory framework. During this period numbers of budgetary support schemes were introduced to provide level playing field to the textile industry of Pakistan. International donor agencies like JICA, GIZ and UN agencies were engaged for technical support for skill development and labor/environment compliances.
- 5. The second textile policy shall conclude by end of FY 2018-19. Textile Division is initiating broad-based and sustainable consultative process to formulate succeeding policy for the period of 05 years, i.e. 2019-24 to keep consistency in regulations and incentives with

ultimate goal to make textile sector competitive and sustainable. The scope of **Textile Policy 2019-24** shall be issues pertaining to supply chain development, infrastructure development, product and market diversification, human resource development trade and investment promotion and facilitation. Furthermore, regulatory measures shall be simplified with view to reduce cost of doing business and facilitate investment as well as imports/exports, in coordination with relevant stakeholders.

- 6. To develop effective policy, coordination with all relevant public and private stakeholders at federal and provincial levels is pre-requisite. In view of forgoing, it is requested input/proposal for Textile Policy 2019-24 may be provided on the specified format (Annex-I) in hard and soft form (on excel sheets on given email IDs), latest by October 10th 2018.
