

Subject: **CONTINUATION OF SUPPLY OF GAS/RLNG TO FIVE EXPORT ORIENTED SECTORS IN CFY 2022-23 AT EXISTING APPROVED RATE US\$6.5/MMBTU OR ANY OTHER REVISED RATE**

Dear Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to convey that the ECC of the Cabinet considered the summary submitted by Ministry of Commerce titled "Regionally Competitive Energy Rates for Export Oriented Sectors during FY 2022-23 (Effective 1st July 2022)" and vide Case No. ECC-224/23/2022 dated July 25, 2022 (ratified by the Federal Cabinet vide Case No. 196/23/2022 dated July 27, 2022) approved the following:

- i. RLNG would be provided at US\$9 per MMBtu all-inclusive to five export oriented industries across Pakistan for all existing connections remaining with the allocation a total subsidy of Rs. 40 Billion as already made by Finance Division in the budget.
 - ii. Petroleum Division in consultation with Finance Division and Commerce Division will review the subsidy requirements and its release on quarterly basis.
 - iii. There shall be quarterly review of the subsidy provided to export industry for both gas and electricity. A report will be prepared by the Petroleum Division, providing list and amounts of all Captive Units of export-oriented sector who are getting subsidy on amount of supply gas/RLNG and subsidized electricity. A similar report on subsidized electricity shall be provided by the Power Division. The report shall be presented to the ECC within a month.
 - iv. The rates will be effective from 1st August, 2022.
2. It is advised to implement the above decision in letter and spirit.

Subject: **REGIONALLY COMPETITIVE ENERGY RATES FOR EXPORT ORIENTED SECTORS DURING CFY-2022-23**

I am directed to refer to Commerce Division's (Textile Wing) letter No. 9(1) TID/12-RDA dated 11.08.2022 on the above subject conveying decision of the ECC of the Cabinet on summary submitted by Ministry of Commerce titled "*Regionally Competitive Energy Rates for Export Oriented Sectors During FY 2022-23 (Effective 1st July 2022)*" dated under case No. ECC-224/23/202 dated 25th July 2022. The Federal Cabinet vide case No. 196/23/2022 dated 27th July 2022. ratified the ECC's decision with certain stipulations.

2. Pursuant to above, XWDISCOs (including K-Electric) are advised to provide electricity @ US cents 9 per kWh all-inclusive to five export-oriented industries (erstwhile Zero-Rated Industries i.e., textiles, leather, carpet, surgical and sports goods) w.e.f. 1st August 2022. It may be noted that the XWDISCOs (including K-Electric) will be informed for continuation of the concessional tariff scheme on monthly basis.
